03.11.1950:	Completed as <i>Santhia</i> for the British India Steam Navigation Company. She was the last of three sisters to be delivered along with <i>Sangola</i> and <i>Sirdhana</i> .
1962:	Withdrawn from the Far East service and transferred to the Bombay/ Gulf service.
1963:	Passenger accommodation now 141 one-class.
08.1963:	On a voyage from Basrah to Bombay, she struck a rock off Harta Bank and sustained rudder damage and grounded. She was towed to Bombay for repairs by the salvage ship <i>Svitzer</i> .
06.12.1966:	Sold to the Shipping Corporation of India and renamed State of Haryana for their Bombay/East Africa service.
1974:	Transferred to the Andaman Islands service and temporarily renamed <i>Nancowry</i> .
11.1976:	Suffered a collapse of her auxiliary boilers.
02.01.1977:	Sold to Zain & Co, Bombay for breaking up once again as the State of Haryana.
